Coupa is a <u>business spend management</u> system Distell is implementing to transform the way we source goods and services, contract, procure, invoice and pay

As a leading **Software as a Service (SaaS)** solution, Coupa offers a **unified spend management suite** designed to help **increase control** and **optimise savings**



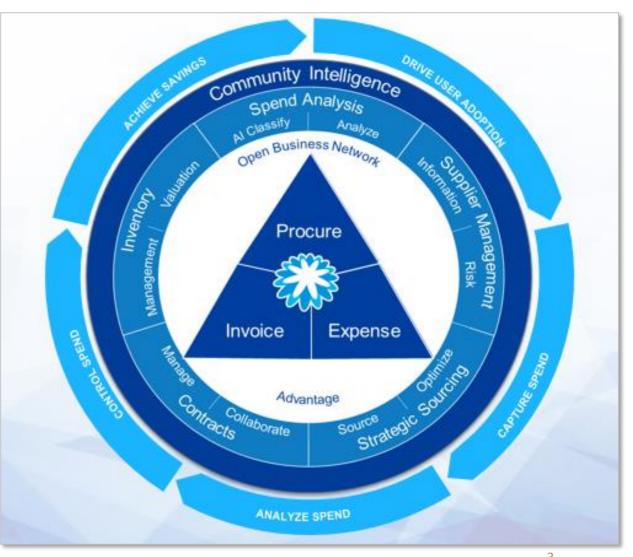
Coupa has developed a suite of applications to help increase compliance, efficiency, and visibility:

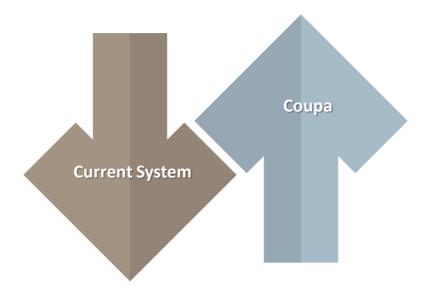
CURRENT SYSTEM

Coupa also enables tracking of purchase orders and payment of invoices electronically

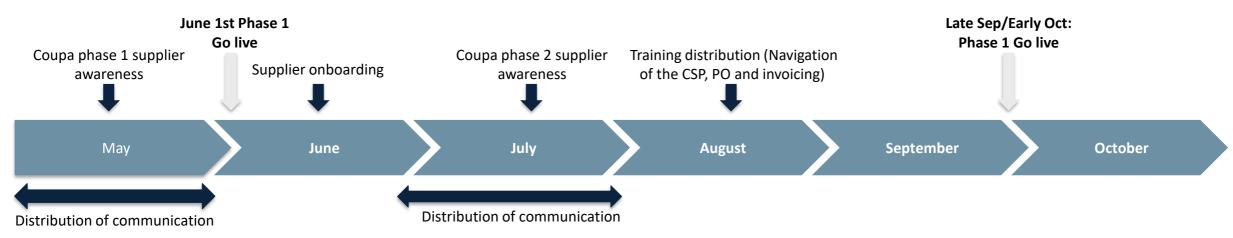
Coupa will solve the following:

Project Roadmap and Functionality Impacted by Each Phase





Phase 1 will go live in July

Distell is implementing Coupa in a phased approach.

Supplier Information Management (SIM), Sourcing functionality (Tenders) and Contracts Lifecycle Management (CLM) will be the first Coupa modules to be launched.

SIM will support requesting, approving and maintaining information about suppliers:

such as financial information, certifications, and contact information, through the use of online forms, approval workflows, notifications, and integrations to financial systems

Sourcing will support Distell's tender process:

the creation in Coupa, the sending to suppliers, managing supplier responses and the adjudicating thereof in Coupa

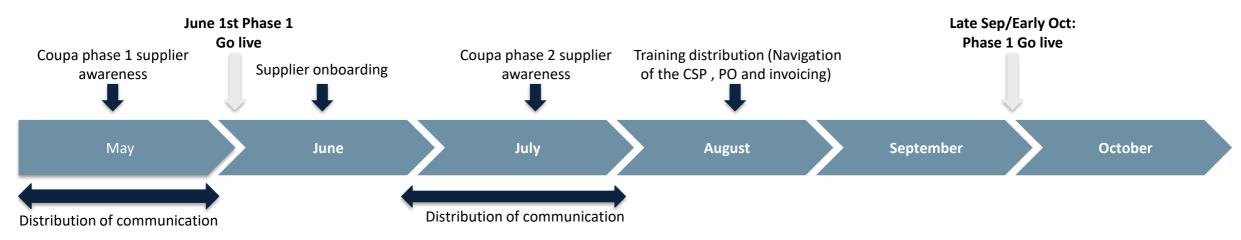
CLM will support internal contract authoring, collaborating and review followed by supplier reviews.

On completion of the contract, spend may be automatically tracked against the contract record for payments



Project Roadmap and Functionality Impacted by Each Phase





Phase 2 will go live in October

Following the launch of Supplier Information Management (SIM), Sourcing functionality (Tenders) and Contracts Lifecycle Management (CLM); Distell will go live with the Procure to Pay (P2P) module.

P2P will support:

The creation of purchase orders (on or off catalogue), to the receipting of goods and/ or services, and processing of invoice for payments – enabling visibility of purchases, invoice and payments and improving cycle time turnarounds.



The Coupa Supplier Information Management Process Explained



Process Objective: The Coupa SIM solution provides Distell suppliers with a self-service capability to manage and update their own organizational information (e.g. contact details, BBBEE certification) on the occurrence of changes (e.g. certificate expiry).



Master Data Administrator

Charles, in the Master Data Team, receives a notification that Delicious Liquors information has been approved and creates them as a supplier on ERP, which activates Delicious Liquors as a supplier in both ERP and Coupa.



Charles, the Master Data administrator receives an email notification from Coupa requesting he reviews and approve John's banking details and conducts an initial due diligence check.



Master Data Administrator





I am John, a new supplier from Delicious Liquors, and I want to sell alcohol to Distell. Let me go to the Distell Corporate website and fill out and submit the New Supplier Onboarding Webform.



Supplier



Oh look, I got a **request** from Coupa to provide more information to Distell, how cool! Let me get the information, **complete** the form and **submit**. That was so easy!



John, receives the email notification supplier request form on the Coupa **Supplier Portal** and eagerly completes and submits the form, along with the required supporting documentation. All gets reviewed and vetted for any potential risks.



HIVE Buyer SHERQ

Ricky, the HIVE Buyer; Anita, the Procurement Manager; Steven the Legal Manager and Susan from SHERQ (if required) receive a email notification from Coupa requesting that they review and approve John's supplier request form; which they happily do.

The High-level Sourcing Process (Not on Catalogue) Explained

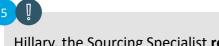


Process Objective: Following a structured process that ensures all legal requirements are met, in order to procure commodity, services or capex – strategic sourcing.





Tom receives the notification that his quote has been approved and does a little victory dance.



Hillary, the Sourcing Specialist receives a notification in Coupa, that Tom's quote has been approved and sends a notification via Coupa to Tom.

Nicola, the **Requisitioner**, needs to purchase a new laptop. She logs into Coupa and searches for a laptop but it is not on catalogue. She fills in the free form and submits the request in Coupa.





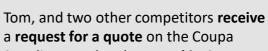


Tumelo, a Buyer receives Nicola's request and checks to see if the laptop is on catalogue which it is not. He then initiates a spot bid for 3 quotes for a laptop from preferred Suppliers.



Jill, the Sourcing Evaluator reviews the 3 quotes from the Suppliers and approves the quote of the winning Supplier in Coupa.





Supplier Portal and respond in Coupa with a quote for the laptop.

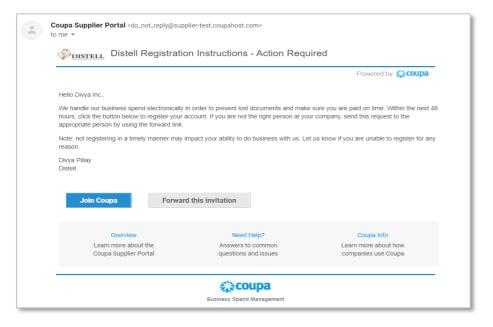

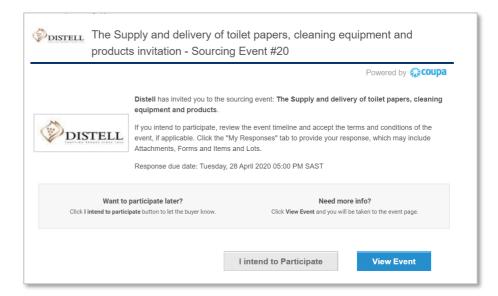


Next Steps
